General Terms of Participation

Valid from 6 November 2019

These General Terms of Participation apply to printed instant tickets for which the results are chosen in advance offered by Swisslos Interkantonale Landeslotterie (subsequently Swisslos).

## **A. General remarks**

Art. 1 In the cantons of Aargau, Appenzell-Ausserrhoden, Appenzell-Innerrhoden, Basel-Stadt, Basel-Landschaft, Bern, Glarus, Graubünden, Lucerne, Nidwalden, Obwalden, St. Gallen, Schaffhausen, Schwyz, Solothurn, Ticino, Thurgau, Uri, Zug and Zurich as well as the Principality of Liechtenstein, Swisslos organizes lotteries with printed instant tickets for which the results are chosen in advance.

Art. 2 Swisslos has the necessary licences to operate the lotteries in accordance with the Federal Act on Gambling of 29 September 2017.

Art. 3 Instant tickets are sold exclusively through Swisslos. For this purpose, Swisslos maintains a network of authorized sales outlets. Third parties are prohibited from trading in instant tickets.

Art. 4 Instant tickets are sold sealed. All instant tickets are identified by letters and/or numbers so that they can be identified unambiguously.

Art. 5 These General Terms of Participation and the Terms and Rules of the individual lotteries can be obtained from Swisslos, P.O. Box, 4002 Basel, or via the official website [www.swisslos.ch](http://www.swisslos.ch). These General Terms of Participation and the Rules of the individual lotteries are binding for the lottery process. By purchasing a Swisslos instant ticket, the buyer acknowledges these General Terms of Participation and the Rules of the relevant lotteries as solely binding.

Art. 6 Swisslos conducts draws under the supervision of the Swiss Lottery and Betting Board (Comlot) or a supervisory body mandated by Comlot.

## **B. Redemption of winning instant tickets**

Art. 7 The deadline for redeeming prizes is six months from the last day of sale. The last day of sale is printed on the instant tickets.

Art. 8 Cash prizes up to an amount of CHF 200 are paid out in cash upon presentation of the corresponding winning ticket. They can be paid out directly by the instant ticket sales outlet or redeemed from Swisslos.

Winning instant tickets of more than CHF 200 are to be sent to Swisslos Interkantonale Landeslotterie, Lange Gasse 20, 4052 Basel (postal address: P.O. Box, 4002 Basel) and will be paid out by Swisslos. To claim the payout of such prizes or otherwise or redeem them, the player must enter his first name and last name, his full address and payment details in the space provided on the reverse side of the entry confirmation ticket or replacement ticket.

For prizes of CHF 10,000 and more, the winner must also provide details of his date of birth and nationality as well as his last name, first name and address and must also confirm that he is the beneficial owner of the prize. Payout cannot take place until these conditions have been met.

Prizes of over CHF 1,000,000 are subject to withholding and income tax.

Examples:

- Winnings of CHF 1,000,000: exempt from withholding and income tax
- Winnings of CHF 1,050,000:
  - o CHF 1,000,000 exempt from withholding and income tax
  - o CHF 50,000 subject to withholding and income tax

For the payout of prizes of over CHF 1,000,000, withholding tax of 35% is deducted from the sum exceeding CHF 1,000,000. Winners receive a withholding tax certificate for the portion of their prize on which withholding tax is levied.

Participants below the mandatory minimum age have no entitlement to the reimbursement of their stakes or the payout of wins.

Art. 9 Redemption tickets are issued for non-cash prizes. Redemption tickets can be claimed for a limited time only. Performance in kind or warranty of title by Swisslos in respect of non-cash prizes is generally excluded.

Art. 10 Prizes which are not claimed or are claimed late will be forfeited and used for the charitable purpose to which Swisslos contributes.

Art. 11 The instant ticket sales outlet and Swisslos will consider the holder of a winning instant ticket to be its rightful owner and the lawful winner. Lost, damaged or torn instant tickets where the prize cannot be clearly established will not be recognized.

Art. 12 For instant tickets which have faulty or unreadable print where the results are shown, the purchase price or stake will be refunded.

Art. 13 Instant tickets entitling the holder to participate in a supplementary game must be sent in to the respective supplementary draw. Senders consent to comply with the Game Rules in force. Unfranked or insufficiently franked entries will be excluded from the draw.

### **C. Legal process and place of jurisdiction**

Art. 14 The sole place of jurisdiction for the lotteries in accordance with these General Terms of Participation is the Civil Court of the Canton of Basel-Stadt.

These General Terms of Participation enter into force on 6 November 2019. Thereafter, all previous provisions issued are no longer valid.
